# Welcome to University of Macau

The University of Macau (UM) is the only public comprehensive university in Macau, and has become one of the most internationalized universities in the world.

With English as the main medium of instruction, the University is committed to training and preparing our students as global citizens.



In recent years, UM has been taking initiatives for a comprehensive and structural reform and entered a new era of unprecedented growth. The University offers the research, cultural, social and recreational facilities you would expect from a top university and lots of greenery to facilitate learning, research and innovation.

You are welcome to visit our gorgeous campus where you can see our strengths and advantages, interact with us, and experience the uniqueness of the UM community!

## Learning Environment

UM offers around 130 degree programmes covering a variety of fields, and the quality education is globally recognized in various university rankings.

The University organizes a vibrant mix of events, competitions, public lectures, seminars, visits or community services to enrich the students' life on campus. You also have opportunities to interact with our invited speakers and leading scholars.

Our Library is the largest library in Macau, with an area of about 30,000 square meters and a collection of over 12 million pieces/items. The Library provides group discussion rooms as well as silent zone for individual study.

There are more than 80 sub-organizations (under the Students' Union), covering academic, culture and recreation, and sports. You can make friends with students from different cultural backgrounds.

## Sports Facilities

The University has various indoor and outdoor sports facilities and you will get free entry access to most of venues by presenting your UM campus card. Our indoor sports facilities include an Olympic-standard swimming pool, a fitness room, sauna, sports pavilion, sport climbing wall, squash courts, badminton hall, table tennis room, etc.



## Campus Outlets

There are more than 25 outlets on campus, providing comprehensive services for your daily needs, including dining, retails, culture and banking.

## Dining

UM has a wide variety of dining choices for multi-culture students. There are food courts that provide East-Asia food like Thai, Singapore, Japanese and Korean food, Chinese-style BBQ pork, dishes and dim sum, Western-style fish & chips and pizza but also fine dining of Chinese and Western restaurant.





## Accommodation

The University provides comfortable and harmonic on-campus accommodation.

Our Residential Colleges system offers a platform for knowledge integration where undergraduate students from different academic disciplines live together in the residential colleges. You can develop a global perspective, think independently and uphold self-confidence in cultural aspect, by communicating and collaborating with people of different disciplines or cultural background.

# STUDENT EXCHANGE

## WHAT CAN I STUDY?

Our exchange students can enroll in any courses available to the students taking full degree programme, provided that you meet the pre-requisites and there are quotas availability. The undergraduate courses cover the following subject fields:

### Faculty of Arts and Humanities

Chinese Language and Literature, English Studies, History, Japanese Studies, Portuguese Studies.

### Faculty of Business Administration

Accounting and Information Management, Business Economics, Business Intelligence and Data Analytics, Convention and Hospitality Management, Finance, Financial Controllership, Gaming Management, Global Business Management, Human Resource Management, Marketing, Professional Accountancy.

### Faculty of Education

Education (Chinese), Education (English), Education (Integrated Science), Education (Mathematics), Pre-primary Education, Primary Education.

### Faculty of Health Sciences

Bioinformatics, Medicinal Science, Pharmaceutical Science.

### Faculty of Law

Law (in Chinese Language), Law (in Portuguese Language), Law (in Chinese and Portuguese Language), Chinese Law and Global Legal Studies.

### Faculty of Social Sciences

## How to Apply?

We only accept nominations from our exchange partners and you should apply through the International Office or Department Office of your home university.

You need to provide the following supporting documents for your application:

1. Academic transcript
2. Curriculum vitae
3. Course selection form
4. Recommendation letter

After your application is accepted by UM, you will receive a link for course pre-enrollment and upload the following documents:

1. 1.5 inches white background color photo
2. Copy of the personal information page of your passport / travel document

## Scholarship

UM provides scholarship to incoming undergraduate students with valid foreign passports and good academic records to participate in UM credit-bearing semester exchange programmes. Applicants from UM strategic collaboration partners and countries will be prioritized.

Each awardee will receive a fixed amount of MOP15,000 (~USD1,800, ~EUR1,700) after his/her registration at UM. The scholarship is normally delivered in October (for exchange in fall semester) and March (for exchange in spring semester).

## VISITING STUDENT RESEARCHER

The Visiting Student Researcher Programme provides opportunities for postgraduate students to conduct research at UM. Participating students will be attached to a Faculty/ Institute and engaged in research activities under the supervision of UM's academic member(s), with a minimum duration of 3 months and a maximum of 12 months.

Students coming via a faculty-level visiting student researcher agreement are limited to conducting research under the supervision of a specific faculty/institute that hosts the agreement. Students coming to UM via a university level agreement may conduct research at one of UM's faculty/ institute. The student's research direction should match that of the proposed host supervisor and must meet the academic and/or research requirements of the proposed host supervisor. Students should consult their supervisor or relevant advisor at home institution for the research plan at UM.

### Eligibility

Postgraduate students (including Master and PhD students) who meet the following requirements are eligible to apply for the Visiting Student Researcher Programme.

- complete at least two semesters of study of their current degree programme at home university before the commencement of the research attachments;
- fulfill the minimum language requirement and specific requirements of applied faculty/ institute (if any).

Application Period	Visiting Period
March to April	commence between July to December of the current year
September to October	commence between January to June of the subsequent year



## How to Apply?

We only accept nomination from our partners, individual applications will not be accepted. Students interested in applying for visiting student researcher programme to UM should approach your officer/ advisor at your home university for more information.

A set of the following nomination documents should be submitted to the Global Affairs Office / Host Office at UM via your International Office/ Department Office:

1. Application form
2. ID Copy (both sides of the ID card must be copied on the same page of an A4-size paper)
3. Passport Copy (applicable to foreign applicants only)
4. Latest academic transcript
5. Official Testimonial
6. CV (including academic qualifications, research activities, publications, awards, etc.)
7. Research plan
8. Language proficiency certificate, if any

## Experience Macau

Macau was a territory administered by Portugal and now a Special Administrative Region of China. Macau's architecture, art, religion, traditions, food and community reflect the integration of Chinese, Western and Portuguese cultures.

The Historic Centre of Macau was inscribed on the UNESCO World Heritage List due to its unique historical and cultural landscape. Thanks to its rich history and cultural diversity, Macau has gradually developed into a metropolitan city and currently positioning itself as the World Centre of Tourism and Leisure as it develops into a quality international tourist destination.

## Climate

Macau has a humid subtropical climate and seasonal changes are heavily influenced by monsoons, the climate is warm and humid with a fairly wide variation in temperature over the year.

Seasons	Months	Temperature
Spring	March – April	15 to 25°C
Summer	May – September	21 to 32°C
Autumn	October	21 to 27°C
Winter	November – February	11 to 18°C

Macau is a city of events and festivals, with an exciting calendar throughout the year. Other than traditional Festival like Lunar New Year and western festivals like Easter and Christmas, Macau hosts many large-scale international events and festivals which varies from arts and film, to food and sporting events.
